We would like to inform you that, beginning January 1, 2026, our community will transition to a new trash service provider. The new vendor will be Waste Management. Christmas and New Year's Day closures

The Community Offices will be closed on **Thursday**, **December 25th**, in observance of the Christmas holiday and will reopen at **8:00 AM on Friday**, **December 26th**.

The Community Offices will be closed on **Thursday**, **January 1st**, in observance of the New Year's holiday and will reopen at **8:00 AM**, **Friday**, **January 2nd**.

What should they do if they are away from their home for the holidays?

When leaving the premises for an extended period during the winter months, do not turn off the heat completely. Instead, lower the thermostat to a safe setting of approximately 50°F to 55°F. Maintaining this temperature helps prevent frozen pipes and reduces the risk of water damage.

Holiday Decoration and Lighting Guidelines

To maintain the safety, appearance, and integrity of our community, residents are asked to observe the following standards regarding holiday decorations and exterior lighting:

- **Placement of Decorations:** Holiday decorations and exterior lighting are permitted only when positioned below the edge of the roof gutter. Decorations are not permitted in the second-story areas of the home.
- **Attachment Methods:** The use of staples, nails, screws, or other mechanical fasteners to secure decorations or lighting to homes or associated structures is strictly prohibited. Plastic clip-on hooks may be used for attaching decorative lighting, garlands, and similar items. Nothing may be affixed to vinyl siding.
- Decoration Standards: All holiday decorations must be in good taste and consistent with the traditions and standards of the holiday being observed. Decorations must be removed by January 10th.
- Electrical Safety: All electrical decorations must be unplugged when the Tenant is away from the Premises.

- Please place bins at the curbside after 6:00 PM the evening before collection.
- Ensure bins are at the curb by 7:00 AM on collection day.
- All receptacles are to be removed and stored by 8:00 PM on collection day.

What to do with extra holiday trash –All items must fit within the designated trash containers in order to be collected. Please break down cardboard boxes and place them inside the bin so that the lid can close securely. We appreciate your cooperation in helping keep our community safe, clean, and orderly this holiday season.

How to dispose of their live tree after the holiday?

You can dispose of your Christmas tree for FREE at the Department of Public Works, but you <u>MUST</u> register first at <u>ChicopeeMa.gov</u>. Please ensure that you remove all tinsel, ornaments, and hooks. They will not be taken in bags. Please be advised that they are closed on Sundays and Mondays.

Winter Weather Safety& Snow Removal Guidelines

As winter weather arrives, we ask all residents to observe the following guidelines to ensure community safety and efficient snow removal operations:

No Roadway Parking During Snowfall: Parking is strictly prohibited on all roadways and grass areas during impending or active snowfall. Please monitor weather forecasts closely. Vehicles must be removed prior to a storm so that road surfaces can be pre-treated and cleared effectively. Any vehicle left on the roadway during snow removal or treatment will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Snow Removal from Driveways and Sidewalks: When clearing your driveway and sidewalk, do not shovel or snow blow snow into the main roadway. This creates hazardous conditions, narrows the road, reduces visibility, and increases the risk of accidents. Please place snow onto the lawn area adjacent to your driveway.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our community safe and ensuring that snow removal operations can be completed efficiently.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Holiday Decorating: Decorating the home is a long-standing tradition around the holidays, but it is essential to practice good safety habits when selecting decorations. In homes with small children, it is important to avoid holiday decorations that are breakable or contain sharp edges. Keep decorations with small parts out of the reach of children and avoid trimmings that look like candy or food, as they may attract extra attention from children. Holiday Lights

Every year, holiday lights should be tested for safety prior to use. If you choose to purchase new lights this year, look for a label indicating that the lights were independently tested for safety. Whether they are new or old, inspect each set of lights for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections.
