#### **Summer Wading Pool Guidelines**

With the warmer weather, we'd like to remind residents about the approved use of small wading pools.

To keep things safe and community-friendly, please follow these guidelines:

- Only pools under 12 inches in height are allowed.
- Water must not exceed 12 inches in depth and must be emptied daily.
- For safety purposes, adult supervision is required while in use, and when not in use, pools must be emptied, flipped over, and properly stored.
- Hot tubs, large swimming pools, spas, whirlpools, fountains, and ponds are not permitted.
- As a reminder, residents are responsible for restoring damage to the lawn caused by a pool or any other summer water toy.

**Backyard Maintenance Reminder** - If you have a fenced-in yard, please remember that routine upkeep—including mowing, raking, weeding, and trimming—is your responsibility.

To keep our community looking its best:

- Grass should be kept between 2–5 inches in height.
- Rake leaves and grass clippings regularly to support a healthy lawn.
- Maintain shrubbery and remove weeds as needed.

If a fenced yard needs attention after an official reminder, the Community Management Office may help coordinate mowing or cleanup. In those cases, the cost may be billed to the residents of that home.

**Smart Conservation Tips for a Healthier Community** - Even if utility costs aren't passed on to residents, being mindful of energy and water use helps keep our community sustainable, efficient, and comfortable for everyone.

Here are a few easy ways to contribute:

- **Use Light Thoughtfully** Open shades to welcome natural light and close them during hot days to help keep interiors cool. Turn off the lights when rooms are unoccupied.
- **Thermostat Settings** Set your thermostat to 78°F during warmer months to reduce strain on cooling systems and support energy efficiency.
- **Water Awareness** Shorter showers and washing laundry with cool water can conserve resources and lower overall usage.
- **Unplug When Possible** Devices still draw power when not in use. Unplug chargers and electronics to reduce unnecessary energy draw.
- **Switch to LEDs** LED bulbs use up to 75% less energy and generate less heat, which is great for comfort and energy conservation.
- **Bring Nature In** Houseplants improve air quality, reduce air-filter strain, and overall enhance indoor environments.

# **SAFETY TIPS**

Studies have shown that even on mild days in the 70s, the temperature inside a parked vehicle can rapidly rise to a dangerous level for children, pets, and even adults. Leaving the windows slightly open does not significantly decrease the heating rate.

HMC urges you to review the tips below from the National Weather Service to keep you and your family safe. For more tips like these, visit <u>Weather.gov</u>.

- Touch a child's safety seat and safety belt before placing the child inside to ensure it's not too hot.
- Never leave a child unattended in a vehicle, even with the windows down.
- Always make sure children have left the car when you reach your destination. Don't leave sleeping
  infants in the car for any reason.

#### **Drivers-Please Remember:**

- Stop for the bus when lights are flashing and the stop arm is extended. Never pass a bus that's loading or unloading children.
- Slow down in school zones and watch for children who may dart into the road unexpectedly.
- Stay alert near bus stops, especially during pick-up and drop-off hours.

#### For Families and Students:

- Arrive at the bus stop at least five minutes early.
- Stand back from the curb until the bus comes to a full stop.
- Remind kids to stay seated, keep the aisle clear, and follow the driver's instructions.
